



Development Contract

The purpose of this document is to give you an in depth explanation in laymen's terms of what to expect in the design of your web site. This is to ensure that our direction of the site design is clear and concise so as to utilize both of our company's efforts in the most efficient manner.

See below for an explanation of the contract sections:

- A. This section includes three items. The total amount of time is calculated in man-hours needed for site completion. The total amount is the monetary cost based on man-hours times the hourly rate. The time to completion is the estimated business days from signing the agreement from which the project will be completed.
- B. Each page and/or section on a site will fall under one of the following levels (with the exception of dynamically created pages such as database generated pages):
 - Level 1 - Basic text up to 1000 words, basic graphics with a maximum of 4 digital format images not requiring any modifications.
 - Level 2 - Advanced text (coloring, etc.), advanced graphics (images needing modification to colors, etc.), basic CGI/Perl with a maximum of 15 fields for forms.
 - Level 3 - Custom CGI/Perl programming, basic database and/or Ecommerce development.
 - Level 4 - Advanced and/or custom development that do not fall under the categories listed above. This work will be listed on an attached schedule.

The total number of new/modified pages lists the sum total of pages that are being created from scratch PLUS the number of existing pages that are being modified.

The number of concepts/prototypes is the number of motifs or possible layout structures requested by the client to evaluate.

The number of unique graphics/images includes all unique images included in the site, but does not count same images of different sizing as unique.

- C. This section is reserved for use by JASKE.COM, INC.
- D. This section is reserved for additional information, such as schedules that are attached or specifics to the project that need to be listed.
- E. Payment and development is broken down into phases. A percentage of the quoted amount is due when the quote is accepted and signed for phase one (quote). This percentage is an equal amount based on the total number of phases (for example - 25% per phase for 4 phases). Upon completion of each subsequent phase, the client will review the work and fax back the contract with the next phase signed and a check will be remitted for the next % due. Proofs will be available at the following web address: <http://www.domain.com/proof> (replace "domain" with your domain name/URL). Work will not progress on subsequent phases until the approval signature and payment is received for the prior phase. Definitions are listed below for the breakdown of phases (actual phases are dependant on the total size of the site):
 1. Proof 1 Conceptual, which will include the basic layout and motif
 2. Proof 2 HTML, which will include the graphics along with the text (this includes the HTML coding of the site).
 3. Proof 3 Final, which will include all requested changes to that date and any additional work including scripting, programming, or database work.

All design/development requests (changes, inquires, etc.) must be made via email to dev@jaske.com or fax at 312-873-3852.

There will be a 10% penalty fee (x phase cost/amount, or 1/4 of total site cost) if any payments are not made within 15 business days of a phase approval. Any additions to the development contract will be in the form of an addendum (schedule) and will alter the date of completion as well as the price of the original quote.

If the above information and/or the prototype is not agreeable to the client, said client will be responsible for making the necessary modifications to the above information and/or the prototype page using notes, drawings, etc. to reach the agreed upon site design. If there are any further questions we may be contacted at 773-478-9877. For modifications requested after a phase approval, additional charges may apply.
